## Exterior:

**Breeding type:** Wardy 509 is a big-framed, breed-typical stallion. His head is expressive and because of his vertically-built neck the stallion has an attractive front. He has black coat colour but feathers are not overly rich.

**Conformation:** Wardy 509 has correct conformation with good proportions and has a rectangular model. The poll has length and the satisfactorily long neck is vertically placed. The shoulder has the required sloping conformation, the well-developed withers show a flowing connection to the back. The topline presents a strong and correct connection from back and loins to the croup. The croup has the right length with lightly sloping conformation. Because of the long foreleg body shape is horizontal.

**Legwork:** The legwork radiates quality. Foreleg conformation is correct. The hind leg has a bit of an upright pastern.

## Performance Test:

**Training report:** Wardy 509 has developed well in the course of the test. In the early stages he suffered from tension, staying tight in the body and rushing along which negatively influenced the contact on the reins and rideability. In the course of the test he developed a better balance which helped to improve rideability. Wardy 509 responds well to training and catches the eye with his very active use of the hind leg. He demonstrates great willingness to work. His very good walking technique also stands out. In canter Wardy 509 has progressed well and has developed a much better balance. He makes a fine picture as a riding horse. Positive assets in driven work are his good walk and strong, roomy movement. Wardy 509 has learned to move with more balance in driven work. He has a naturally good elevation in movement. Trainability in driven work is good. As a show driving horse he should develop more front.

**Walk:** The powerful and regular walk is roomy and well through the body in all disciplines.

**Trot:** The trot is characterised by good action and scope. The hind leg is placed well forward under the body showing ample flexion in the hock joint. The foreleg shows knee action and is generously placed forward. At the end of the test Wardy 509 demonstrates good balance in front of the carriage. Trainability in trot is good and he moves in a naturally satisfactory uphill frame. **Canter:** The canter is powerful and strides have more than satisfactory uphill quality. Balance in canter has increased in the course of the test.

## Riding horse aptitude:

Wardy 509 has lots of aptitude for dressage work. He displays good trainability and more than satisfactory self-carriage. He has good and strong movement technique with more than satisfactory quality in canter.

## Driving horse aptitude:

Wardy 509 is very talented for driven work.

In front of the carriage he moves with balance and rise in the front. Wardy 509 has good technique in trot showing good transitions in which his strong use of the hind leg positively catches the eye. The foreleg shows lots of knee action and is generously placed forward. He demonstrates lots of forward-go and is easy to train in front of the carriage. As a show driving horse he should develop more front.

## Findings Performance Test:

Wardy 509 has shown a positive development throughout the test. He has strong technique in movement with more than satisfactory suppleness. His trainability is good and he presents a fine picture as a riding-, driving- as well show driving horse. For show driving he must learn to move with more front.

## Final conclusion:

Wardy 509 has good lineage and a very

good exterior and has completed a positive test in all three disciplines. On the basis of these results he has been registered in the Studbook.

## Dam report:

**General:** The now 18-year-old Star Preferent Performance mare Annegjen has stayed in very good shape and was presented in fine condition. The mare displays more than satisfactory breeding type. The head is expressive with a slightly longish face. She is not overly rich in feathers. The mare has correct conformation and a good rectangular model. The poll has more than satisfactory length and the long neck has satisfactory vertical conformation. The long shoulder has sloping conformation. The topline is fluent with strong connections. Croup conformation is slightly sloping and with satisfactory length. Stance of the hind leg is correct and radiates quality. She walks with long, powerful strides, stepping well through the body. She has a roomy trot and the hind leg is placed well forward under the body showing ample flexion in the hock joint.

**Dam line:** Wardy 509 was bred from the now 18-year-old, excellently preserved Goffert 369 daughter Annigjen who flaunts the predicates Star, Preferent and Performance. She has seven Star offspring with one Crown, one Model and two Sport offspring among them. The most well-known offspring are the approved Maeije 440 and the multiple National Champion broodmares in front of the sjees Ytsjen Model Sport. Wardy's granddam is a Model Sport mare by Feitse 293 and his 3rd dam is a Star, double Preferent Performance mare by Hearke 254. Wardy 509's pedigree unites two of the most prominent show driving lines. On the maternal side these are the show driving mares of pedigree 8. His sire Hette 481 harks back to the famous mares Fabiolaa and Ljurkje who produced the brothers Ulke 338 and Karel 370.

## Advice:

Wardy 509 is expected to improve model, attitude, the walk and leg technique.
