Exterior:

Breeding type: Yme 507 is a stallion with an appealing front. With his small head and neck with good vertical build this stallion exudes breed expression.
Conformation: Yme 507 is a stallion with a strong physique and a little bit of a square model. The head/neck connection is light with more than satisfactory length of poll. He has more than satisfactory slope in the shoulders. The connections between withers, back, loins and croup are flowing and strong. Croup conformation is slightly steep but no more than average. Body shape is a bit downhill partly because of the slightly short foreleg.
Legwork: Stance of the foreleg is a little base-narrow. The stallion slightly lacks dryness of legwork. The hind legs are a bit sickle-hocked.

Performance Test:

Training report: In the test Yme 507 has amply demonstrated his talent for riding horse. The stallion has good use of the hind leg which he always places well forward under the body. He moves with an appealing posture and shows a lot of go in work. The stallion is easily distracted which does at times affect his rideability. He should therefore learn to move with more relaxation in the topline. In the course of the test the contact on the reins, and consequently also rideability and use of the body, improved and then he responds well to training under saddle. He has a talent for canter. Because of his attractive front he presents a beautiful appearance in all disciplines. Yme 507 has more than satisfactory aptitude as a driving horse. His capacity for transitions is good and uphill outline is satisfactory. A positive asset in driven work is his use of the hind leg. In show driving he makes a really fine front but he must learn to develop more rise in the forehand.

Walk: Yme 507 naturally walks with satisfactory activity and length of stride and satisfactory use of the body. When he becomes anxious the walk can be affected.

Trot: The trot has satisfactory scope and is powerful with satisfactory use of the body and suppleness. The hind leg is placed well forward under the body showing ample flexion in the hock joint. In the foreleg we see satisfactory reach in front and knee action.

Canter: He has a good-quality canter. At this stage the canter is still a bit rushed but with uphill strides and with more than satisfactory posture. He has more than satisfactory capacity for transitions in this pace.

Riding horse aptitude:

With his good canter, mentality and trainability Yme 507 proves to have lots of talent for dressage under saddle. In all three paces he presents a naturally good posture

and responds well to training, giving his rider a more than satisfactory, good feeling.

Driving horse aptitude:

Yme 507 has satisfactory driving horse aptitude. In this discipline he displays good movement technique with satisfactory use of the body responding with more than satisfactory trainability. In driven work he has a naturally good posture. Because of his use of foreleg and hind leg Yme 507 has satisfactory aptitude for show driving. Trainability in this discipline is satisfactory. In show driving work the stallion presents a satisfactory front but must learn to move in a more uphill frame.

Findings Performance Test:

Yme 507 has made good progress in the course of the test. He shows more than satisfactory trainability and more than

satisfactory suppleness. He has a good mentality and great willingness to work giving his rider/driver a good feeling which is more than satisfactory. As a show driving horse he should develop more rise in the forehand.

Final conclusion:

Yme 507 has good lineage and has completed a good test in which he has developed well. He has proven to be very talented for riding work and has more than satisfactory aptitude for driving and show driving. On the basis of these results he has been registered in the Studbook.

Dam report:

General: Because of her impressive front his dam Hadewich Hyllested Østergaard has great allure. She has a fine rectangular model with a satisfactory, uphill build. She has an expressive head. The poll is long and the long neck has a vertical build. She has satisfactory slope in the shoulders and a flowing topline with strong connections. The croup is long but slightly steep. The legwork shows quality with satisfactory stance. The walk is roomy, powerful and active. The trot has satisfactory ground-coverage and power.

Dam line: Yme 507 was bred in Denmark from a mare line founded on stallions that have had relatively little influence on breeding. His dam is a Model mare by Bente 412 who also has the Sport predicate. His granddam, a Wierd 409 daughter, also has the Model predicate as well as Preferent status. His 3rd dam is a Star mare by Oltman 317 with three Star offspring. The 4th mare in the mare line is the famous Jakob 302 daughter Beitske fan Marksatthe. She is Star Preferent and Performance and can boast eleven Star offspring. These horses from pedigree 25 stem from the same line as the Preferent Norbert 444.

Advice:

Yme 507 is expected to improve breed expression, use of the hind leg and the canter. He is a good match for mares with satisfactory, uphill build.
