Exterior:

Breeding type: Siebren 547 is a stallion with great breed expression. He has a noble head with a friendly expression. Vertical stance of the neck is satisfactory, the neck is long with a light head-neck connection.

Conformation: Siebren 547 is a longlined stallion with horizontal build and good length in the foreleg. He has a long, slightly steep shoulder, a closed and correct topline with wide and well-connected loins. Croup conformation is correct in terms of shape and length.

Legwork: The legwork is a bit coarse but overall quality and dryness is satisfactory. He has lightly capped hocks in both hind legs. Siebren 547 has correct stance of the hind leg, but is a little narrow in the foreleg and somewhat standing under. The stallion's feet are generously developed. Locomotion of the foreleg is a little toeing-in.

Observations stable manager, riders and drivers:

Siebrén 547 has a fine character with an uncomplicated personality; he is friendly, inquisitive, very constant in the work and still easy to train in moments when stallion behaviour comes to the surface.

Central Examination:

Siebren 547 has completed the examination as a 3-year-old. The stallion has shown lots of progress throughout the test, both under saddle and in driven work.

Training report:

Walk:

Siebren 547 is regular in the walk but strides are a bit short with little stepping over. In the walk he remains tight in the topline, which stops the hind leg from following sufficiently through. The foreleg too should develop more forward reach. The stallion presents an active, diligent walk with satisfactory bend in the hind leg. When the stallion relaxes in the topline during stretching forward and down, the scope in walk improves considerably. Both riders and drivers point out that the walk feels short and a bit tense, but remains regular.

Trot:

The trot shows self-carriage, with lots of ground-coverage and use of the body. Siebren 547 has a beautiful forehand, makes a fine posture, rises in the withers and is light-footed. The stallion can effortlessly extend his strides in trot while keeping up the rhythm and regularity. His capacity for transitions is good, he keeps engaging the hind legs and the foreleg reaches far forward.

Canter:

The canter has strongly improved in the course of the test. Siebren 547 canters well from the hind leg with uphill strides. He has good balance in canter, responds well to training in this pace and shows capacity for transitions.

Riding horse aptitude:

Siebren 547 has natural balance and suppleness in trot and canter and is always enjoying the work. The stallion performs transitions with ease and active use of the hind leg. He is an all-round utility horse with a very good uphill canter and great balance. Siebren 547 is very responsive to the aids and is an intelligent horse. He demonstrates satisfactory forward-go. The stallion must learn to relax more in the walk and loosen in the topline.

In-harness aptitude:

Siebren 547 is an all-round horse and certainly shows to be talented for showdriving too. The stallion moves in an uphill outline, makes front and has good zest for work. In trot he moves with good flexion in the hind leg, shows a long moment of suspension, suppleness and capacity for transitions. The walk is short but active. The stallion shows good trainability and willingness in the work.

Conclusions Central Examination:

Siebren 547 has successfully completed the CE in all three disciplines. During his training sessions the stallion demonstrates great zest for work with a lot of go and throughout the test he has shown progress in the canter. The trot shows good posture, use of the body and technique. The walk still needs attention.

Dam report

Bente P.W. Star is an 8-year-old Star mare from pedigree 50 who has given four offspring. So far Siebren 547 is her only Star offspring. Bente P.W. is out of the Doaitsen 420 daughter Annette van 'e Hamsterheide Model Sport AA, who along with the Model predicate has also obtained the Sport predicate in dressage. Annette advanced to Z2 dressage and after that also earned her spurs in Limit Classes showdriving.

Bente P.W. is in good condition and is still frequently used for driven work. The mare has a friendly expression and calm personality.

Bente is a mare with a little bit of a downhill build, good breed expression and a long mane. She has a long, well-connected neck, a correct topline and a croup with satisfactory length that is slightly sloping down. Her legwork shows satisfactory quality and large feet.

The walk is active and rhythmic, but should show more ground-coverage. In trot the mare moves with powerful use of the hind leg, which is placed well forward under the body. She displays a satisfactory moment of suspension, although the rhythm is a bit rushed.

Final conclusion

Siebren 547 is an all-round stallion with three correct basic gaits. A stallion who displays lots of balance and suppleness in trot and canter. Siebren 547 demonstrates to enjoy his work under saddle as well as in the harness.

Advice for use:

Siebren 547 should be used for mares with a good walk. He is expected to add balance and flexion to the hind leg as well as improve mentality and trainability.
