Exterior:

Breeding type: Pelle 545 is a cool-looking stallion with great breed expression. He has a noble and very expressive head and vertical conformation of the neck, with a little bit of an under-neck. The stallion would benefit from a slightly lighter head-neck connection, but poll length is satisfactory. Pelle 545 presents an elegant outline with satisfactory feathers.

Conformation: Pelle 545 is a longlined stallion with horizontal build and good length in the foreleg. Shoulder conformation is long but somewhat steep and in his topline the connections could be a little stronger. Croup conformation is correct in terms of shape and length.

Legwork: The legwork is a bit coarse but of good and dry quality. The hind leg is a little sickle-hocked and the foreleg is a bit back-in-the-knee. Pasterns are long and the stallion has generously developed feet. Locomotion of the left foreleg is a little toeing-in.

Observations stable manager, riders and drivers:

Pelle 545 is a people-minded, slightly dominant stallion. He is friendly but quite focused on other horses and therefore easily distracted. This is accompanied with some stallion behaviour too, but has improved throughout the examination. When he is focused he is great to ride and combines it with a good mentality.

Central Examination: Training report:

Pelle 545 has completed the examination as a 3-year-old. Throughout the test the stallion has gained in strength and also in suppleness and use of the body, which is expressed in more ease and trainability in his performances. Sometimes the stallion is still easily distracted, which mainly affects the quality of his walk.

Training report:

Walk: In walk Pelle 545 moves with rhythm and satisfactory length of stride. He can be easily distracted which causes the strides to lose some of its tread.

Trot: The trot shows self-carriage with lots of rhythm and good use of the hind leg, great technique and capacity for transitions.

Canter: The stallion moves in a high-quality canter with his balance catching the eye. Pelle 545 shows good transitions in canter without the need for speed.

Riding horse aptitude:

Pelle 545 is an all-round utility horse with a very good uphill canter showing lots of balance. He has satisfactory forward go but is fairly easily distracted. The stallion must learn to relax more in the walk and loosen in the topline. Pelle 545 shows to have a natural talent for technique and balance in trot and canter.

Driving horse aptitude

Pelle 545 visibly enjoys the driven work and moves with an uphill posture. He makes a good front and has a carrying and active hind leg. Thanks to his good use of the body the stallion is easy to train, has lots of forward go and promptly reacts to the driver's aids. The walk always remains a bit tense and with little use of the body. Thanks to his good forward reach of the foreleg, lots of front and lots of technique in the hind leg, this stallion exhibits great aptitude for showdriving.

Conclusions Central Examination:

Pelle 545 has successfully completed the CE in all three disciplines. During his training sessions the stallion demonstrates great zest for work with a lot of forward go and throughout the test he has shown progress in the canter. The trot shows very good posture, use of the body and technique, especially in the driven parts of the CE. The walk still needs attention.

Dam report

Lobke van 't Lansink Star Sport Preferent Performance AAA died last spring of old age, at the age of twenty-one. The mare has given sixteen offspring with eight of them being declared Star or higher, which makes her double Preferent and therefore Crown Jewel. Lobke's first daughter is Model mare Wyp van 't Lansink Model Sport Preferent Performance AAA (Beart 411). She has obtained her Sport predicate in dressage and scored 83 points in her IBOP under saddle.

Because of the death of dam Lobke her daughter Wyp van 't Lansink Model Sport Pref Perf AAA (Beart 411) was inspected. This mare has satisfactory breed expression and a strong topline. Dry quality of her legwork is satisfactory for a 17-year-old horse. Wyp shows a good walk moving well through the body and demonstrates satisfactory self-carriage as well as satisfactory length of stride in trot. Pelle 545's half-sister Amarins van het Lansink was also inspected. She is a 16-year-old Star mare by Haitse 425. Amarins is a well-built, big-framed mare and considering her age still has pretty clean and dry legwork. Her walk and trot are satisfactory.

Final conclusion

Pelle 545 is an all-round stallion with three correct basic gaits. A stallion who displays lots of balance and suppleness in trot and especially in canter. The work comes easy to Pelle 545, both in under-saddle as well as in driven work.

Advice for use:

Pelle 545 stems from a dam line with a good breeding record and his dam has great breed expression and stature. Therefore the stallion is expected to improve breed expression as well as balance and technique of the hind leg in canter. The advice is to use Pelle 545 for mares with a roomy walk.
