Exterior:

Breeding type: Tygo 556 has great breeding type. Head expression could be a bit more aristocratic. The neck is long and vertical, but a somewhat lighter head-neck connection would be preferable.

Conformation: a longlined stallion with horizontal build and very good length in the foreleg. Shoulder conformation is good and the topline is correct. Croup conformation is sloping with satisfactory length.

Legwork: The legwork is fine and dry with generous, well-shaped feet. Stance of the hind leg is a bit cow-hocked and sickle-hocked. The stallion has slightly sloping pasterns in the foreleg.

Observations stable manager, riders and drivers:

Tygo 556 has pleasant contact manners. He reacts well to the aids, is extra good at transitions and the riders describe him as a complete horse. He is easy to train and has a strong urge to perform. Variation and due encouragement are a huge stimulus to Tygo 556. Tygo is a sensitive horse with great potential.

Central Examination:

Tygo 556 successfully completed the Central Examination at the age of three. In the course of the test he has shown great progress, both under saddle and in driven work. The stallion enjoys the work, is very eager to work and always shows strong commitment. Both riders and drivers describe him as an easy to train and reliable stallion.

Training report:

Walk: The stallion possesses a very good walk which at all moments – in transitions, extensions and stretching forward and down – remains very regular. Overstepping is generous and he shows good bend in the hock.

Trot: The trot is light-footed with good suppleness, but needs to develop a bit more self-carriage. The stallion presents a fine forehand, producing good posture and good lift in the withers. Extending the trot comes easy to him, while keeping tact and rhythm. The stallion has satisfactory capacity for transitions but needs to develop more alacrity from the hind leg.

Canter: The canter shows spacious strides with ample use of the body and balance.

Riding horse aptitude:

The stallion has a very good walk by nature. He is attentive, always enjoys the work and is cooperative. The stallion's transitions are satisfactory but he must learn to bring the hind leg further forward under the body. He proves to be an all-round utility horse with a very good walk. The aids are well-established and the horse is very eager to work and has satisfactory forward go.

The stallion possesses very good mentality and proves to be an all-round utility horse. In trot and canter he moves with strong natural suppleness and balance. He volunteers great zest for work, is easy to train and has lots of impulsion.

Driving horse aptitude:

In driven work the stallion moves in an uphill outline, makes front and shows great zest for work. In trot he moves with good bend in the hind leg and moves with good rhythm, moment of suspension and suppleness. Capacity for transitions is satisfactory, but he should show more active engagement from the hind leg and needs to relax more in the topline. The stallion also shows aptitude for showdriving horse.

Conclusions Central Examination:

The stallion has successfully completed the Central Examination in all three disciplines. During the training sessions he demonstrated lots of drive and forward go. The walk is very good, roomy and regular. The trot is characterised by ample suppleness and the canter has very good balance.

Dam report:

Thirsa fan Jentjes Pleats Stb Model Sport AA is a youthful 11-year-old Model mare of proportionate build with good breed expression. The mare's head shows satisfactory noble expression with a light head-neck connection. The neck is long and vertical. The shoulder has satisfactory length and sloping

conformation. The mare has a strong topline and good croup conformation and length. Her legwork is clean and dry. Stance of the legwork is correct seen both from the front and the side. The dam has a remarkably good walk and hence the walk seems to be well-embedded in this stallion. The trot is light-footed, powerful with a long moment of suspension but the foreleg needs to develop more forward reach.

Final conclusion:

Tygo 556 is an all-round stallion with a very good walk which positively catches the eye. In trot the stallion presents very good posture and use of the body, but self-carriage from the hind leg needs to improve a bit. The canter has good quality with ample balance and suppleness. The stallion enjoys his work and displays lots of aptitude both under saddle and in the harness. Riders as well as drivers point out that the stallion shows good responses to the aids as well as to training.

Advice for use:

Tygo 556 is expected to have a positive influence on the walk and can also improve trainability and suppleness.
